Why Repurposing Matters

Big names look prolific but to be honest, most aren't creating everything from scratch. They're repurposing.

Their core ideas flow through books, card decks, courses, podcasts, journals, and workshops - expanding their reach without reinventing the wheel every time.

Repurposing helps you:

- Save time and energy.
- Build visibility and credibility faster.
- Discover new product ideas hiding in plain sight.
- Grow your income from the work you've already done.

FIND YOUR STARTING PIECE

Step 1: Collect

Pick one piece of content you already have — something you've poured heart, insight, or creativity into.

- Blog post
- Article or email
- Workshop notes or slides
- Course module
- Lead magnet
- Podcast episode
- Client tool, exercise, or handout

AI as your Brainstorming Partner

We are going to play with AI as a brainstorming partner. I recommend ChatGPT, Claude is a great option too. You will want to convert your chosen content to a pdf and then upload to your AI project. Be sure to let AI know you are wanting to brainstorm re-purposing possibilities with the content you just uploaded.

REPURPOSING PROMPTS

Now let's play. Use 1 or 2 of these prompts with the AI platform of your choice to spark ideas for how your content could expand into new forms.

Expand

“Turn this short piece into a 700–900 word blog post. Keep the tone warm, casual, and creative.”

Condense

“Summarize this into 3 short social media posts. Each under 150 words and ending with a question to spark engagement.”

Reformat

“Outline and draft a simple 2-page lead magnet based on this content. Include a title idea, 3 main takeaways, and one simple action step.”

Transform

“Turn this content into an outline for a mini-course or workshop. Suggest 3 lessons, key outcomes, and one creative practice activity.”

Multiply

“List 5–7 more ways this content could be repurposed - examples might include a podcast, checklist, journal prompts, or a short video series.”

Which of these feels easiest — or most fun — to try first?

PRODUCT POSSIBILITY PROMPTS

Use these questions to spark more product or program ideas from your existing material (feel free to brainstorm with AI as well)



Does your blog, talk, or chapter suggest steps or a process? Could that become a course or signature method?



Do your topics have natural themes or sections? Could each become a module, a mini-training, or even a card deck?



What passages, stories, or quotes could turn into visual prompts, journaling cards, or reflection exercises?

PRODUCT POSSIBILITY PROMPTS - continued



Are there recurring phrases or ideas that could inspire a poster, card deck, or a micro-content series?



Look around your space right now. Choose a symbol or object that represents the impact you want your work to have.



What does that symbol have to tell you about your next product or program?

REFINE + SYSTEMIZE
